

The concept of Color Jenga is inspired by the classic game of Jenga, originally created by Leslie Scott and published by Hasbro.


Jenga is a game of physical skill that challenges players to carefully remove and stack blocks without toppling the tower.






Thank you to Leslie Scott for creating the original Jenga game, and to the many designers who have experimented with variations of this classic game over the years.


